



# **Chatting from Jim**

Dear Neighbors,

I want to convey how pleased we are that the Stony Point Town Council has recognized our need and increased our budget for the first time in ten years.



Supervisor Monaghan has been in dialog with us over the past year and we owe him and all the Council members a sincere thank you! The new additional funding will help us stabilize our cash flow position in 2019 and begin to allow us to gradually restore budget cuts that have been recently required. In order to accomplish this however, we still have made several modifications to the 2019 Library Budget. We hope that these will only be temporary adjustments.

Principally we have decided that we shall shorten the weekday evening hours to 8:00 pm. The number of library users from 8pm to 9pm Monday-Thursday is often so few that we are wasting time and money. On Saturdays we will be open from 10am to 4pm; and on Sundays we are trying a new schedule from 12:00pm to 4:00pm. Other little economies are being made that may hardly be noticed, but when added together will provide a reasonable savings.

So what's new? Well the answer is really "stayed tuned" for upcoming announcements, since we are now in a protracted planning stage. I attended the NYS Library Conference in Rochester and came away with a folder full of new ideas that may be useful for the future Rose Memorial Library. The sessions I attended dealt mainly with how to address current trends and build up services that are truly useful to adults and children in the 2020s. One program that has been successful in many libraries is providing services to entrepreneurs and people who need to supplement their primary income. Maker-Spaces, Technology like 3-D printers, design products and databases with demographics and in depth-research are on my radar, while educational programs for seniors, younger adults and children are in my dreams. I believe these can be accomplished with an expansion of library space. I hope to be able to take some babysteps with these ideas in 2019.

Please let me hear from you, especially about what you would like to see happen at the Rose Memorial Library!
