ELECTIONS - BOARD OF TRUSTEES

**Annual Meeting, December 16, 2015
Rose Memorial Library, 6:00 P.M.**

A seven-member Board of Trustees governs the Rose Memorial Library Association. Trustees are elected by the members of the Association and serve a three-year term. All registered voters, eighteen years of age or older, residing in the town of Stony Point, New York, are eligible for membership and may vote in the election.

Candidates for Trustee Positions

Two trustee positions will be vacant at the end of 2015:

Two, 3-year terms (January 1, 2016 - December 31, 2018)
Incumbent Christine Silverstein will be running for re-election.

Other candidates may run for election according to the following procedures:

A petition signed by fifteen (15) qualified voters shall be required to place a name of an individual on the ballot.

Petitions should be submitted to the Board Secretary (c/o the Library Director) prior to the Annual Meeting by December 11th, 2015.

All Board members must be residents of the area served by the Rose Memorial Library.
